Remember your tuning is symmetrical, so you can play any chord upside down. Try fretting the first or melody string at the 2nd fret instead of the bass, as shown and see how it sounds. If you were tuned to DAA, the IV chord would be a G, and this would be the chord constellation for a G Major chord in that tuning. ...
